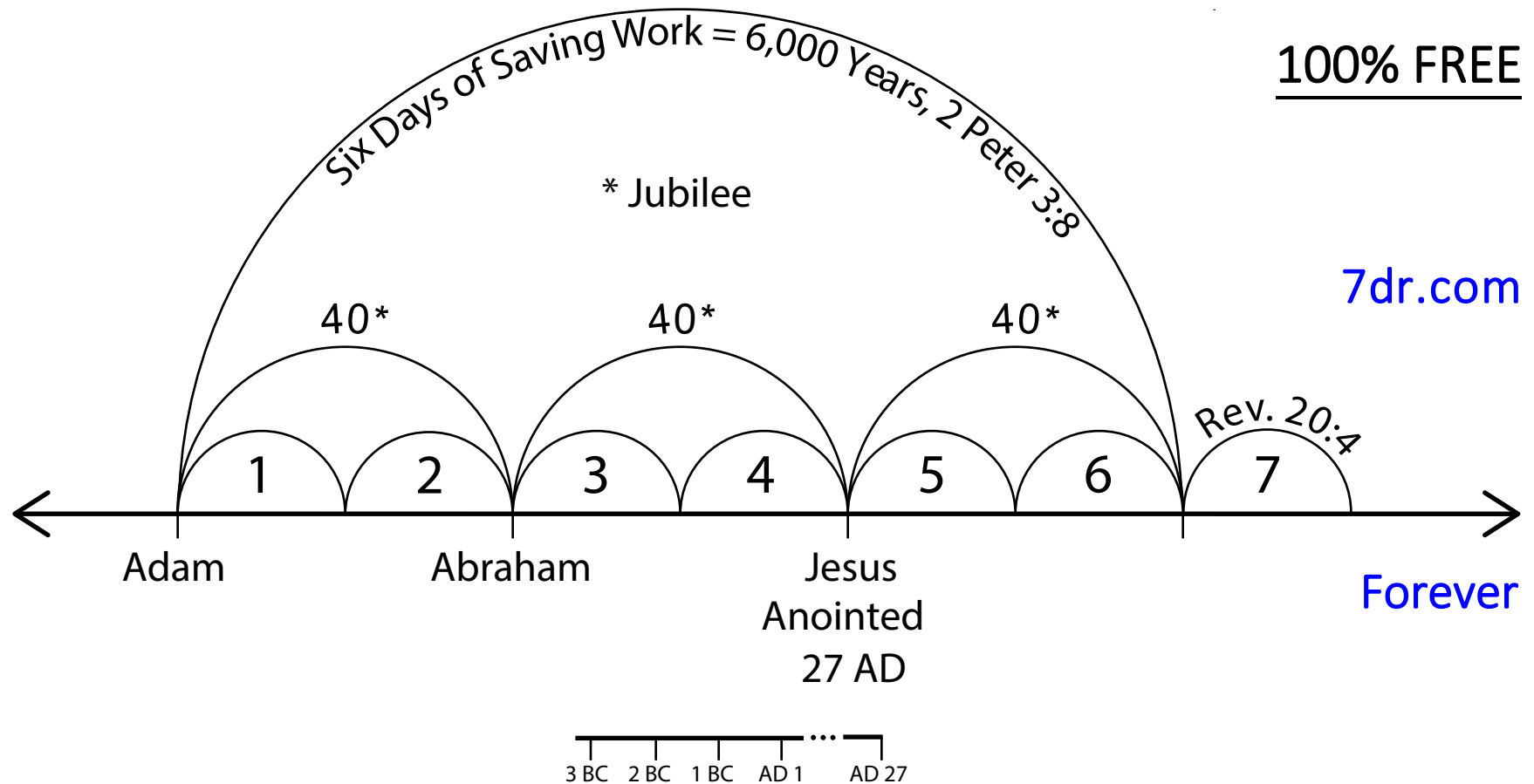


God "is longsuffering... not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9



- Jesus was born around fall/autumn of 4-3 BC. He was anointed (baptized) at 30 years old. Note that there are no year 0 in the calendar. 1 BC is followed by AD 1 or AD 0001.
- God teaches His way about 6 days/years work followed by a 7th day/year rest and, a jubilee year: Genesis 1 and 2:1-4 ; Exodus 20:8-11 ; Exodus 21:2 ; and Leviticus 25.
- A jubilee is the year following $7 \times 7 = 49$ years, Leviticus 25 verses 8 and 10. The 50th year is called a jubilee year (redemption/liberty). Hence, $40 \text{ jubilees} \times 50 \text{ years per jubilee} = 2,000 \text{ years}$, and $120 \text{ jubilees} \times 50 \text{ years per jubilee} = 6,000 \text{ years}$.
